

Conditions of Sale

1. We guarantee this puppy to the best of our knowledge, to be in good health, free of diseases and have received its first vaccines and dewormings at the time of the sale. The breeder is not responsible for the death or loss of this puppy once it leaves our premises, due to sickness, accidents, injuries or theft. The breeder is not responsible for refunds due to human allergies, disability, illness, or other related situations. The breeder is not responsible for refunds due to changes in coat, color, not bonding with the puppy or because the temperament is not what you expected. As the breeder we try to the best of our ability, to match each puppy to the likeness of its' new owner.
2. The owner assumes all financial responsibility for the puppy including but not limited to vet expenses, AKC/CKC registration, food, surgeries, boarding grooming, etc.
3. The owners assume responsibility to continue quality healthcare for the puppy. This puppy will require monthly dewormings and a series of vaccinations. You are highly encouraged to keep your puppy current with all necessary vet checks. If your puppy has been purchased as a pet, it is strongly recommended that your puppy be spayed/neutered. This is usually done around 16 weeks of age.
4. You have 4 days after purchase date (receiving the puppy date) to take the puppy to a licensed veterinarian for a complete physical. If for any reason the vet finds a defect in the puppy that will cause certain premature death, the breeder agrees to refund the purchase price upon the return of the puppy to the breeder, at the owner's expense. A refund will only be given upon a written report from the vet responsible for performing the exam. The vet will need to provide the breeder with all the test results and a diagnosis in WRITING on the veterinarian's letterhead. This refund will only be given providing that the breeder's veterinarian of choice verifies the defect. The presence of parasites such as worms, Giardiasis, or Coccidia does not make a puppy defective. We attempt to send your puppy home parasite free. After the above date this guarantee is not valid. The breeder is not responsible for any vet bills acquired by the owner.
5. We guarantee hips against any genetic defects for one year of the puppy's life (from the puppy's date of birth). We guarantee against hip dysplasia with mild or better rating by the Orthopedic Foundation for Animals (OFA) up to one year. You must have an official written documentation from OFA of dysplasia rates of severe or moderate, before a replacement puppy is given. We will not honor a written statement or exam from your licensed veterinarian. It must be documented through OFA. Although we are careful to breed animals with great temperaments, no guarantee can be given regarding your puppy's temperament.
6. The breeder will not sign AKC papers until you check has cleared and payment is in full. I reserve the right to revoke the registration and obtain possession of the puppy if payment is made with a check containing insufficient funds. You will be subjected to a \$50.00 service fee.
